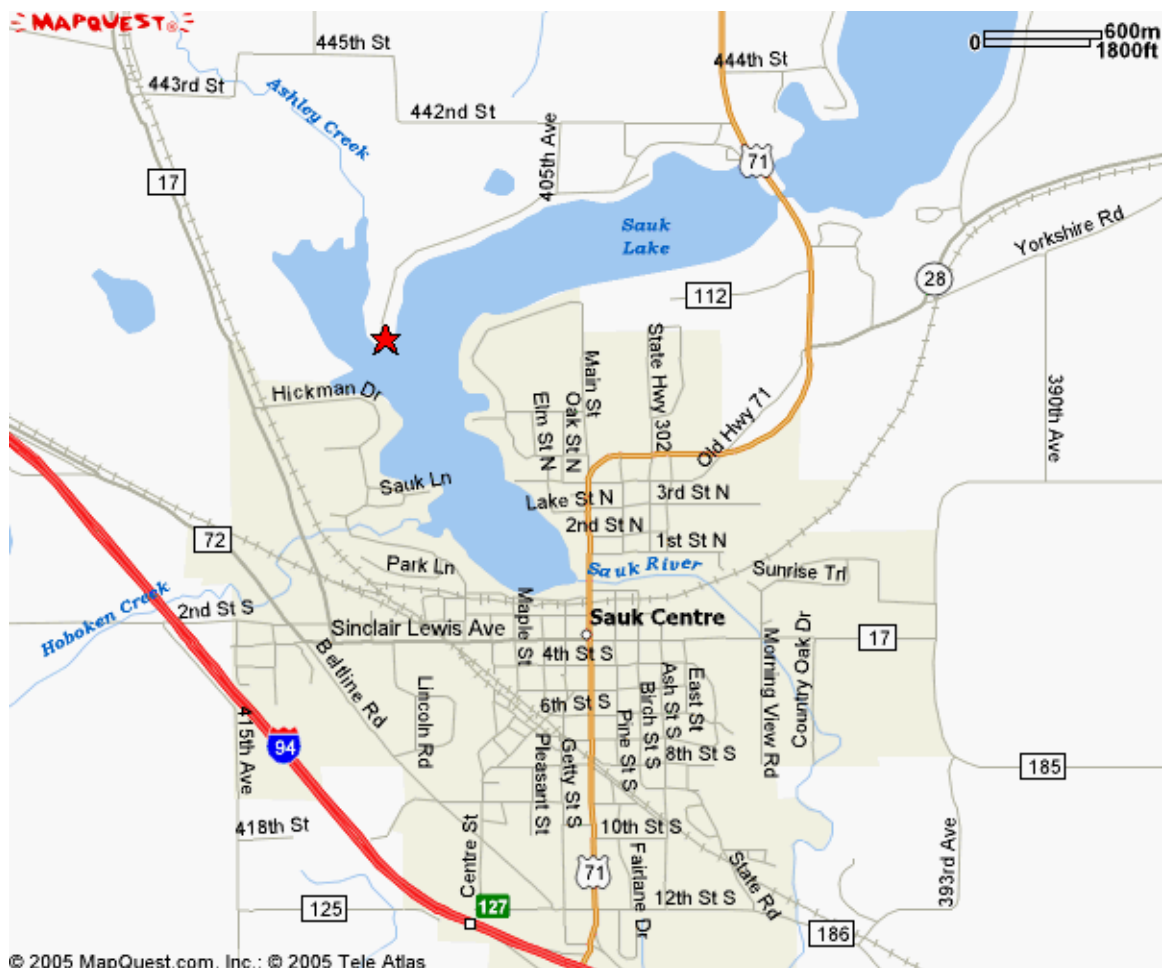


Directions to The Lodge on Sauk Lake

Things to know for The Lodge on Sauk Lake

Please Read Thoroughly – New Items May Be Below

**To learn how to use the TV's, lights/fans and microwave, go to:
www.thelodgehowto.com for an instructional video.**

Wi-Fi – There is free Wi-Fi with high speed Internet for you to use. The network name is: The Lodge The password is: 6123258745

TV – We use Hulu Live on all 3 TV's. Go to: www.thelodgehowto.com to learn how to use them.

Trash/Recycling – There are garbage bags for you to use in the kitchen (drawers to the left of the kitchen sink). Please put all garbage bags into the dumpster in front of the garage. Please put your recycling into the recycling bucket. Recycle day is Wednesday.

Garbage day is Monday (you don't have to do anything, they pick up the dumpster). Recycle day is Wednesday. Please DO NOT put garbage in the rolling recycling bucket.

Microwave-

To use the microwave-

(make sure you have the glass tray in the microwave).

1. Push microwave button.
2. Turn the large dial to the right 1 click to Cook Time. Press the dial in to select.
3. Turn the dial until you have selected your desired microwave time. Press the dial in to select.
4. Push the dial one more time and the microwave will start.

Range – This is a gas range. Push the desired burner knob in and turn to Light to ignite the burner. Then once lit, turn the knob to your desired intensity.

Kitchen Sink – We are on a septic system and do not have a garbage disposal. Please throw all food waste in the trash.

Dishwasher – We have dishwasher soap for you to use underneath the sink.

Refrigerator – If you hear a beeping sound in the kitchen, it is coming from the refrigerator. This means a door is not shut all the way.

Items in the Kitchen – Feel free to use the items (utensils, spices, etc) in the kitchen for your cooking needs.

Keep Food Items Off the Countertops – Please try and keep food items in the cabinets. This ensures we won't have an issue with mice.

Bathrooms – We have a septic system. Please only throw toilet paper down in the toilet. All feminine products need to be thrown in the garbage.

Towels – Please bring your own beach towels. We have kitchen towels for you to use in the middle drawer to the left of the kitchen sink. We have bath towels, hand towels and washcloths for you to use. You can find them in the bathrooms.

Great Room Fireplace – There is a remote control to use the gas fireplace in the great room.

Downstairs Fireplace – This fireplace is not operational. Please do not use it.

Toys and Miscellaneous items in the hall closet next to the TV and in the guest bedroom closet – feel free to use these items. There are also random beach toys in the plastic box outside the bunk room door. Please return them before you check out.

Grill on the deck – This is a Weber gas grill. There will be extra LP tanks in case you run out.

Bonfire – Feel free to use our wood next to the paved fire area. But, please do not go overboard with using the wood. It does cost money. Please do not go into our neighbor's yard and use theirs. Please make sure that your fire is of a manageable size. Check with the DNR about fire bans during your vacation.

Docks – We have two docks that you may use. They are both in the front of our property. The best swimming area is just to the right of the main dock (large aluminum dock).

Leaving the Property – When you leave the property, please lock up the house. To leave, just press the Schlage logo. It will lock automatically. If you logged in to the TV's with your own Netflix or Amazon Prime accounts, make sure to log out.

Caretaker – Ron Pederson may be on the property during your vacation (in the trailer behind the garage). He keeps to himself, is here to help you. There are a lot of things that pop up here. Please talk to Ron about any issues that may arise.

Bedding – Please put the bedding you used in the laundry room. That way the cleaners know what beds were used. If you want to start a load, that would be appreciated. It reduces the time our cleaners need to spend. If you aren't comfortable operating the washing machine, that's ok too.

If you see something that needs attention, please let us know right away. We will do what we can to get someone in to fix it or replace it. We want to make sure your stay is enjoyable and that anything that doesn't meet your expectations is remedied as quickly as possible.

Pontoon – If you are renting the pontoon, talk with Ron Pederson – caretaker

How to use the pontoon

- The key is in the ignition.
- The gas tanks are full, please return them full.
- There are 2 gas tanks in the back corner of the pontoon, behind the seats. You can change from one tank to the next full one, by changing over the gas line.
- To refill the tanks, go to the Brother's Market & Gas Station (right on Highway 71, the first gas station on the way to town) and fill with regular 87 octane unleaded gas. Their address is 321 Main Street.
- Straight gas in the tank. No need to mix oil. It is a 4-stroke engine.

Starting instructions:

- Turn the key.
- If you try a couple times and it doesn't start, lift the 'fast idle' lever ½ way up while turning the key and it will start.

Check-In and Check-Out Times:

Check-In is at 3:00 pm

Check-Out is at 10:00 am

(we have to have it be this early to allow our cleaners need enough time to get the house ready for the next set of renters that will be checking in later that day.)
